

Assessor/Recorder/County Clerk Donates \$10,000 to Polinsky Children's Center

Assessor/Recorder/County Clerk, David L. Butler is proud to donate \$10,000 to the A.B. and Jessie Polinsky Children's Center. The presentation of the check will be made at the Board of Supervisors' meeting on October 12, 2010 at 9:00 a.m.

This donation is funded by a portion of the proceeds from the sale of photographs taken during marriage ceremonies performed by Butler's office. With this latest donation, the department will have donated nearly \$100,000 to the Polinsky Center since 2000. The pictures are among a series of keepsake items Butler's office offers for sale.

David Butler, also the Commissioner of Civil Mar-

riages states, "We are exceptionally pleased that we can provide couples with a memento of this joyous occasion while at the same time helping the children at the Polinsky Center."

This facility is a 24-hour temporary emergency shelter for abused, neglected, and abandoned children. During FY 2009-10, the Center served over 2,000 children, with an average daily population of 59 children and an average length of stay of 12 days. The Center uses monetary donations to purchase extra items for the children, such as new clothing, movie tickets, fast food certificates, and recreational activities.
